1.0 Introduction

The 2022 Annual Action Plan is prepared from the Achiase District's Medium Term Development Plan, 2022-2025. It also embodies Action Plans of the various Departments of the Assembly. The District Medium Term Plan is drawn from the six development dimensions of the Government's Co-ordinated Programme of Economic and Social Development, christened the Agenda for Jobs II: Creating prosperity and equal opportunities for all.

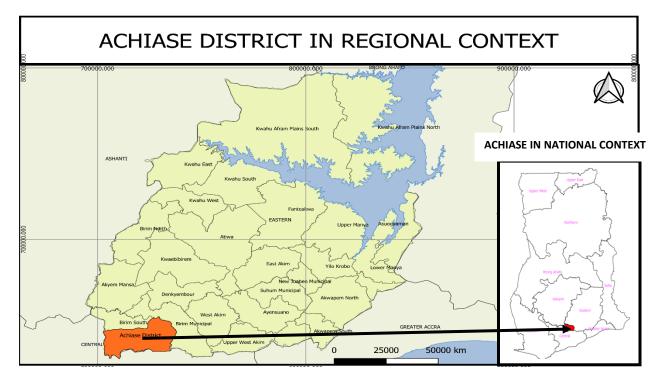
1.2 Mission

The Achiase District Assembly exists to provide conducive socio-political and economic conditions for actualization of the dreams and aspirations through provision of timely and appropriate policies and services to all

Brief District Profile

The Achiase District was created from the Birim South District in 2018 by L.I 2370. The District which is located at the south-western part of the Eastern Region is covers an estimated land area of 501km² and it is bounded by

Asene Manso Akroso to the North-East and Birim South to the North West. It also shares boundary to the south by Districts in the Central Region, namely Asikuma Odoben-Brakwa, Assin Central Municipal and Assin North District.



2.1 Population Distribution

The 2021 projected population of the District is 90,721, and it is expected to increase to 92,646 in 2022 at a growth rate of 2.1% (projected from 2010 Population - 73, 537). Sex disaggregation of the population in the District follows both the national and regional trends where females out number males. Females represent 51.6 percent of the population against 48.4 percent males. Females constitute 50.4% while males constitute 49.6%. Children under 15 years constitute 40.1% of the District's population.

2.2 Economic Activities

Agriculture engages 65.9% of the economically active population whereas the service and manufacturing sectors engage 19.4% and 14.7% respectively.

Major food crops cultivated are cassava, maize and plantain and the cash crops are cocoa and oil palm. Livestock reared in the District are sheep, goats, poultry and pigs.

The Ahuntan, Norma and Odwira festivals celebrated in the District. The Jungle Warfare School and Green Farms and Tourism Limited are some of the major tourist attractions in the District.

2.3 Road Network

Total length of roads in the District is 127.1km. Earth surface road is estimated to be 95.3 km. More than 70% of the roads are in bad state.

2.4 Education

There are 153 schools including 52 pre-schools, 56 primary schools, 43 JHS, and 2 SHS. Privately owned schools constitute 30.1% of schools in the District.

2.5 Health

The District has 15 Healthcare facilities, including 2 Health Centers and 13 CHPS Compound. Four (4) of the CHPS Compound operate in temporal structures, i.e. either rented or in a wooden structure. Malaria ranks first on the top 10 OPD attendance

2.6 Water and Sanitation

Potable water coverage in the District is 61.5%. Proportion of the population with access to improved sanitation services is 43.0%.
